



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

## Tree Month - Reed




October 28th-November 24th Druids considered reed, a giant grass, as a tree due to its dense root system. Reed symbolizes protection, royalty, & male divinity. One reed deity is the Breton King of the Underworld. An Ankou collects the souls of the deceased & escorts them to the Land of the Dead. Redeared, white dogs act as psychopomps & provide safe passage to the underworld.

## Samhain - All Hallows Eve




- October 31st

#### Invocations

### Personal Experience of the 'Source'

- > Usually an individual aspect of divinity
- > Powerful, not omnipotent, but with own will
- > Hence, the need to call or summon

#### Desire

- > Know what you call
- > Read... search...
- > Research!
- > Set personal altar to appeal to Them
- Begin forming words of power



### Invocation In Actions

#### Intention

- > Communicate directly with Chosen Deity
- > Clear mind through meditation
- > Reach receptive relaxed mental state
- > Release preconceived notions about invocation
- > Surrender to process of communion

### Invoking

- > Call on the Chosen Deity
- > Repeat words of power you created
- > Rock gently, tugging' to create a pathway
- > After connecting, communicate as you wish
- > If Deity desires not to commune, be respectful

# Spells

Magic

Combines psychic energy with willpower to cause a change to conformity or shape Nature

> Three sources: Personal, Earth, or Divine

Spellcraft

> Specific set of actions, words, and/or events which culminate in movement of energy

> As you set purpose, remember the Rede

Consider correspondences

Directions, tools, sun, stars, moon

> Physical health & mental well-being

> Magic & spellcraft are secondary to worship


